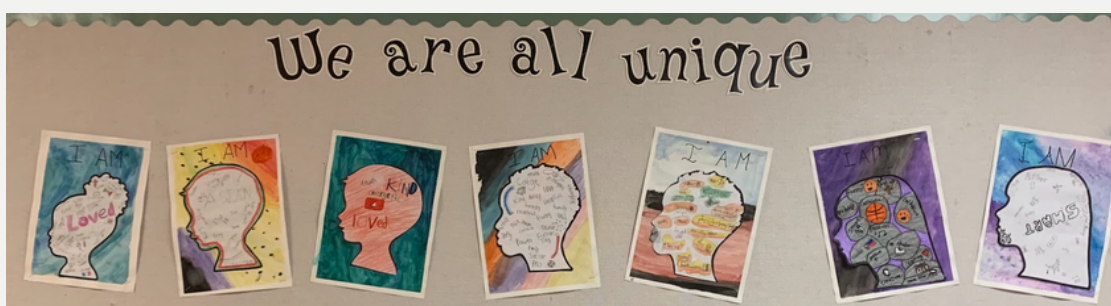

School Updates



KENSINGTON

The Kindergarten class continued their daily prayer, readings, and weekly bible stories. They learned a song called “I’ve got the Joy”. Additionally, they participated in many discussions about things that they are thankful for and made a Fall craft called “Thank you God...”

In Grade 3/4, the class continued to focus on gratitude throughout their daily life. The Grade 5/6 students have been talking about how they can lean on God when they are feeling sad. Their conversations have been around trusting that God will give us the strength during tough times. They use an analogy that life is like a rollercoaster and that God can give us the strength during the chaotic twists and turns that we experience in life.

In the Junior High, students took part in the development of improvisational skills, focusing on using our faith to support us when we experience sadness.
