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## President: Description of Position

The President is elected by Logos Members at the Annual General Meeting (AGM).

Time Commitment:

3. Communicate with the Board online: email, Google Docs, etc.

Responsibilities:

1. Be familiar with the Edmonton Logos Society Bylaws & Handbook.
2. Attend and chair all the meetings of the board and all meetings of the general membership
3. Prepare meeting agendas and ensure all board reports are distributed in advance of meetings
4. Liaise with school principals and EPSB on matters concerning the Logos program
5. Stand as an ex-officio member of all committees of the Society
6. Act as a spokesperson for the society
7. Act as signing officer for financial transactions, cheques, and other official documents of The Society
8. Create initiatives and volunteer as the lead on committee(s) of your choosing.
9. Work closely with the Vice-President, Treasurer, and Secretary.

If you have gifts and talents that are currently underutilized, this position will allow you to join with other like-minded parent volunteers to bring events and initiatives to life.
